Religious Education	Year 5 will cover 3 units this term: Parables of Jesus Stories of the Early Church
English	Literacy will be taught in a two hour block every day. Students will participate in a variety of reading, writing, speaking and listening opportunities, including modelled, shared, guided and independent writing and reading tasks. Our focus in reading this term to use a range of comprehension strategies and our knowledge to help read, view and comprehend a wide range of texts. Our focus in writing this term is to compose, edit and present well-structured and coherent imaginative texts, including poetry.
Mathematics	Mathematics will be taught for one hour every day. Students participate in a number based warm up, a rich learning task and reflection time. The topics we will cover this term include: Whole Number, Two-Dimensional Space, Angles, Addition and Subtraction, Three-Dimensional Space, Multiplication and Division, Area, Fractions, Decimals and Percentages, Length, Patterns and Algebra, Chance.
Creative and Practical Arts	Specialist Creative and Practical lessons are with Mrs Grace Camilleri and Mrs Melanie Siroklyn. The focus of this term will be dance, where students will learn and perform a range of choreography, as well as work in groups to create a dance sequence. Visual Arts themes and lessons are: Pieces of Me- Collage Unit
Personal Development, Health and Physical Education	Specialist Physical Education lessons are with Mrs Cristy Budd and Mr Joe Ng, this term year 5 will be participating in two units of work. First will be a striking and fielding unit, where students will be given the opportunity to develop their skills and confidence in a variety of contexts. The second half of the term year 5 will be participating in a target games unit. In Personal Development the unit covered is Active and Healthy .
