Religious Education	<p>Year One will cover two units this term:</p> <p>Stories of Jesus: The students will learn about the importance of the Bible, and will study stories about Jesus, and stories that Jesus told.</p> <p>Senses - A gift from God: The students will learn about stories where Jesus healed others, and gain an understanding that their senses are a gift from God.</p>
English	<p>Literacy will be taught in a two hour block every day. Students will participate in a variety of reading, writing, speaking and listening opportunities, including modelled, shared, guided and independent writing and reading tasks.</p> <p>Our focus in reading this term is for students to use comprehension strategies to understand a text.</p> <p>Our focus in writing this term is for students to compose a range of imaginative, informative and persuasive texts.</p>
Mathematics	<p>Mathematics will be taught for one hour every day. Students participate in a number based warm up, a rich learning task and reflection time. Our focus this term is to encourage students to use multiplicative thinking, and to prove their answers in more than one way.</p> <p>The topics we will cover this term include: Whole Number, Two-Dimensional Space, Addition and Subtraction, Three-Dimensional Space, Multiplication and Division, Length, Fraction and Decimals, Area, Patterns and Algebra, Chance.</p>
Science:	<p>Year One will cover two units this term:</p> <p>Spot the Difference: The students will learn that objects are described by their physical properties and that physical and chemical changes occur when energy is added or removed.</p> <p>Look! Listen!: The students will develop an understanding of how light and sound help us to communicate in our world. They will develop their understanding of how light and sound travels and how they are produced.</p>
Creative and Practical Arts	<p>Specialist Creative and Practical lessons are with Mrs Grace Camilleri and Mrs Melanie Siroklyn. The focus of this term will be dance, where students will learn and perform a range of choreography.</p> <p>Visual Arts themes and lessons are integrated into other Key Learning Areas.</p>
Personal Development, Health and Physical Education	<p>Specialist Physical Education lessons are with Mrs Cristy Budd and Mr Joe Ng. This term Year 1 will be participating in two units of work. The first will be a throwing, catching and kicking unit, further developing those important fundamental movement skills. Followed by a unit on target games.</p> <p>In Personal Development, the unit covered is Keeping Safe. Students will learn how they can keep themselves and others safe in different environments and situations.</p>
