ROAD SAFETY AT ST MICHAEL'S

We have made it! In working together around a building site, we have gained maximum safety and smooth exit for all our students. Our drive-through at Orwell Street is "working a charm".

**If you stop in a 'No Stopping' area—
Fine from \$298 + 2 demerit points**



You must not stop your vehicle on a length of road or in an area in which a No Stopping sign applies.

No stopping includes when the vehicle is not moving but the engine is still running

**If you stop in a 'Bus Zone' -
Fine from \$298 + 2 demerit points**



You must not stop or park your vehicle in a bus zone for any reason.

This includes when the vehicle is not moving but the engine is still running

**If you disobey a 'No Parking' sign—
Fine from \$165 + 2 demerit points**



You are allowed to stop your vehicle only to set down or pick up passengers or goods.

Your vehicle must not stop for more than 2 minutes. The drive must not be more than 3 metres from the vehicle.

It should be remembered that "when in procession" you will not be charged for stopping in the above areas. However, the "procession" will only commence from 3:00 pm—3:30 pm. **Before the "procession" commences at 3:00 pm, you can be charged for illegal parking.**
