Week 3: Jan 22-25

Mon - Super Sleuths treasure hunters (Theme day)

Come all you treasure hunters. Indiana Jones. Sherlock Holmes. Captain Hook and Dora the explorers. Try your hand at Geocaching, dig up buried treasure and learn the art of treasure hunting. Dress as a Super Sleuth

See the classic kids' tale in an all-new Australian adaptation by multi award-winning playwright Mary Anne Butler. starring Dubs Yunupingu as Alice – the first time the role has been played by an Indigenous woman. Followed by Lunch at Prince Alfred Square Parramatta. upon returning to COSHC we will be having a COSHC talent show where the children can perform for their peers.

Wed - Moving Bodies Health (Incursion)

Welcome the trainers from Moving Bodies to a full day workshop on Gymnastics and exciting games. Discover health and the human body and learn how to make healthy choices. Dress sensible for rolling and tumbling

Thurs - Australia Day Celebrations (Theme day)

Join us as we explore life as an early settler. learn about our rich Australian History and Acknowledge the land of The Darug people and their local culture and traditions. Families are welcome to join us for a BBQ at 4pm

<u>Children Must Brina:</u> Fruit snacks. morning tea. lunch and a refillable drink bottle. unless otherwise indicated. COSHC will supply breakfast and afternoon tea each day. Children will not be able to purchase food while off site. Please remember that COSHC St Michael's is an EGG and NUT FREE Zone!!!

<u>Children Must Wear</u>: As per our Sun Safe Policy. all children must wear sun-safe clothing with sleeves and collar. enclosed sport shoes & socks and a sun-safe hat (*Legionnaire hat or Bucket hat with a deep crown and wide brim*) for all outdoor play including the excursions. Children will wear COSHC Hi-Vis Vests on all off site excursions.

Parent / Guardian Permission (Please read and initial every statement)

I understand that failure to make the full Vacation Care fee payment by December 11. will result in my child/ren's position at Vacation Care being cancelled without notice.

I understand that no further bookings OR changes to bookings will be accepted after Monday, 11 December 2017.

I agree to abide by all policies and procedures of Catholic Out of School Hours Care.

I accept that children will be supervised at all times. and that all travel between the Centre and excursion venue will be in privately booked buses with seatbelts.

I understand that excursions are compulsory for all children booked in on that day to attend and that the number of participants will not exceed the licensed number.

I understand that "Excursion and Incursion Risk Assessments" have been completed prior to the event and are available to me upon request.

I understand that the educator to child ratio's that COSHC adheres to is 1:15 for onsite days and 1:8 for all excursions (water based excursions are 1:5). Additional educators will be employed where it is deemed to be necessary. based on the activity risk assessment.

I accept that it is my responsibility to ensure we are at the Centre by 8:00am on excursion days (unless another time is specified). I understand that the bus will not wait and I will need to make alternative care arrangements for my child/ren if we arrive after that time.

I understand that I am required to sign my child in and out of the program each day. Written notification is required to allow another person to collect my child if they are not listed as an authorised contact.

I understand that my children may be required to participate in activities that may be physically and emotionally demanding. My children's participation in any activity is non-compulsory. COSHC staff will duly exercise their Duty of Care.

I agree to support the Centre in implementing the Sun Protection Policy by my child/ren wearing Sun-safe clothing with sleeves & collar. sun-safe hat and sports shoes & socks.

I understand that all programs will continue in the event of inclement weather unless notified. I understand that should the scheduled venue need to change due to inclement weather, the back-up venues COSHC will use are the Movies. Bowling and Sydney Aquarium/Wildlife World.

I understand that COSHC will take no responsibility for lost property. This includes all electronic devices.

I give permission for my child/ren to have their face painted and hair sprayed as part of the centre program throughout the holidays.
